

List of potential items for K9 Down Emergency Pack:

All of the following should be tailored to a 60-80# working dog. Those in **bold** should be considered for portable working pack.

- Blanket (for carrying / covering)
- **Thermometer (rectal; digital)**
- Pen light
- Alcohol
- Activated Charcoal (with sorbitol)
- **Nonstick Bandage material (eg. Telfa® pads)**
- **Bandage Scissors**
- Instant cold pack and hot pack
- Cotton Balls
- **Antibiotic ointment**
- **Sterile (NO steroids) eye lube**
- **Sterile eye wash (can use LRS or saline as well)**
- **Muzzle (Basket preferred)**
- **Gauze ties / thin leash (*for makeshift muzzle if you are not carrying one*)**
- **Cuffed endotracheal tube (size 9-10)**
- **Roll cotton (for bandaging)**
- **Roll gauze (cling/conform)**
- **Vet wrap or Coban™**
- Splints (see demos in laboratory) or **Fiberglass cast material and/or SAM® splint**
- **Oxygen mask**
- Peroxide
- **4X4 square gauze pads**
- **Syringes (3, 6, and 12 cc); with needles**
- **Over the needle catheters (16 and 18 gauge for IV; 14 or 16 gauge for gastric trocarization)**
- **Catheter caps**
- Tongue depressors
- **1 inch adhesive waterproof tape (*Note: can tear skin when removing*)**
- 1 inch adhesive tape (NOT waterproof)
- Sterile KY lubricant (1 large tube)
- **Betadine Wipes**
- **Alcohol Wipes**
- **Small portable clippers**
- Large orogastric stomach tube with blunt end
- **EZ-IO® gun and (blue) IO catheter**
- **1 Liter bag(s) of sterile saline or LRS (preferred) with administration sets**
- **Combat Gauze® (roll) or VetClot® (roll) *Note: both made by ZMedica® - human/veterinary, respectively***

Optional Items: Leather bite gloves

Injectable drugs to potentially obtain from a veterinarian with whom you have a relationship:

Naloxone, epinephrine, atropine, vasopressin, benadryl, dexamethasone SP, terbutaline and/or aminophylline, lidocaine, sedatives and/or pain mgmt drugs (dependent upon your licensure/scope of practice)
