NOW RECRUITING DOGS FOR: Melanoma Study



NC State University College of Veterinary Medicine is looking for dogs with melanoma to participate in a clinical study to aid in the advancement of novel therapeutic treatments for melanoma in both dogs and people.

PARTICIPATION

• Study participation requires obtaining two 3mm punch biopsies from the tumor during a scheduled tumor biopsy or removal. Dogs with melanoma that are scheduled for euthanasia due to presence of melanoma are also eligible.

STUDY BENEFITS

• Owner will receive monetary incentive of \$200 for study participation

INCLUSION CRITERIA — In order to participate in this study all dogs:

- Must have oral or cutaneous melanoma
- Have tumor large enough to obtain two 3mm punch biopsies
- Are scheduled to undergo surgical procedure for tumor biopsy or tumor removal
 OR
- Are scheduled to be euthanized due to presence of melanoma
