

Rabies Form

Hi Class of 2022!

Before you start your classes, the College of Veterinary Medicine needs to know your current rabies status. We need to know where you are at today, not where you anticipate being in the near future.

We understand that you may elect to get your rabies vaccine series or titer drawn in October at our rabies clinic, and you can update your rabies record with us at that time.

Please note that due to HIPAA restrictions, we cannot access your medical records with main campus; so, even if you have supplied to them, you will need to share with us as well.

You have two options to notify us of your rabies status:

Option 1 – Elect to start the DVM program by assuming the risk of not having rabies vaccine and/or current rabies titer:

- Fill out the **Declined Rabies Vaccination Acknowledgment and/or Assumption of Risk** form at <https://goo.gl/forms/befYJ0E7xVkewgtC2>.

Option 2 – If you have had the rabies vaccine series and/or a titer with valid levels within the last two years, complete both of the following steps:

- Fill out the **Annual Report** form at <https://goo.gl/forms/0sQveoull4YVw4zg2>. If you filled it out previously, you can click on "Edit Your Response" to update.
- Present proof of the rabies series or valid titer results. You can present this in paper form (which you can elect to leave with us or not), via your medical portal if you can pull this up on an electronic device and show to us, or send a copy via email to dvminformation@ncsu.edu (but only do the last option if you are comfortable sending medical documents via email). If you shared results with main campus already, you might be able to access a PDF copy of your titer results here: <https://healthypack.dasa.ncsu.edu/healthweb/>.
