NC STATE UNIVERSITY

- Dogs that have suspected osteoarthritis in 2 or more joints.
- Dogs that have confirmed osteoarthritis on x-ray.
- Dogs are at least 12 months old and weighing more than 1kg

EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- Dogs that have been treated with antibiotics, antivirals, antifungals or probiotics within the last 30 days.
- Dogs that have lameness known to be related to neoplasia, primary neurologic or immunologic or non-healed fractures.
