

Does your **dog** have **mammary tumors**? We can help!

NC State Oncology is enrolling dogs with mammary tumors in a clinical trial investigating a new therapy called INSPIRE, which uses electrical pulses to safely destroy the membranes of cells within a tumor.

PARTICIPATION -

- You will need to bring your dog to the NC State Veterinary Hospital for an initial diagnosis, diagnostics, imaging, a single INSPIRE treatment, and 4 follow-up CT scans over a 9-month period.
- Monthly follow-up surveys on overall patient health. Total participation is around 24 months.

INCLUSION CRITERIA – In order to participate in this study dogs must:

- Have 1-2 discrete tumors measuring between 1cm and 3cm
- No other contraindicating comorbidities
- Patients must be ≥ 30lbs

STUDY BENEFITS – FULLY FUNDED. Patients will receive a cardiology and oncology consult, bloodwork, thoracic radiographs, abdominal ultrasound, and multiple CT scans.
