



NCSU Clinical Studies is looking for cats that have suspected or confirmed osteoarthritis.

Participation- Clinical Studies is looking for Cats with osteoarthritis to participate in a one-time appointment to obtain an oral microbiome sample. Patients will receive a free examination and have the option to have full body radiographs performed to confirm OA.

INCLUSION CRITERIA

- Cats that have suspected osteoarthritis in 2 or more joints.
- Cats that have confirmed osteoarthritis on x-ray.
- Cats are at least 12 months old and weighing more than 1kg



EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- Cats that have been treated with antibiotics, antivirals, antifungals or probiotics within the last 30 days.
- Cats that have lameness known to be related to neoplasia, primary neurologic or immunologic or non-healed fractures.
- Cats that are FeLV/FIV positive
