

NEW STUDY INVOLVING LIBRELA LOOKING FOR DOGS WITH KNEE OR HIP OSTEOARTHRITIS

NC State University College of Veterinary Medicine and the **Translation Research in Pain (TRiP)** team are looking for dogs who have osteoarthritis to participate in a new study. This is a randomized, double blinded study looking to compare the efficacy of two FDA approved medications. **Half of dogs enrolled in the study will receive Librela.**

STUDY BENEFITS

- **FREE** physical, orthopedic, and neurological exam.
- **FREE** bloodwork and urine analysis.

- **All dogs receive approved medication.**



INCLUSION & EXCLUSION CRITERIA

- Clinical signs of osteoarthritis exclusively in the stifles or hips.
 - Predominantly single limb lameness
- At least 1 year and weigh >20 kg (44 lbs.)
- In general good health.
- Wash out periods will be needed for any dogs on certain pain medications.
- Dogs can receive nutritional supplements/food or mobility diets if they have been on them for ≥ 6 weeks.

PARTICIPATION

- Owners will be required to come to NCSU with their dog for a total of 6 study visits over the course of 2.5 months.
- Give daily oral medication.
