

# Riluzole for Canine Degenerative Myelopathy

The purpose of this study is to determine whether treatment with oral Riluzole prolongs ability to walk in dogs with a clinical diagnosis of canine Degenerative Myelopathy (DM)

## What qualifies my pet?

- Strongly suspected to have DM based on MRI and CSF findings, genetic testing
- Able to walk without assistance and only mild weakness present
- No other major medical problems
- Complete blood count and serum chemistry without clinically significant abnormalities, as determined by veterinarian.

## Client compensation

The study will cover most costs. You will be required to pay for the standard diagnostics that are part of pre-enrollment, and for one set of bloodwork performed during the study, although funds are available to support owners with financial need. If your dog experiences a study-related adverse event, the cost of medical care will be covered by the study up to a total amount of \$500.
