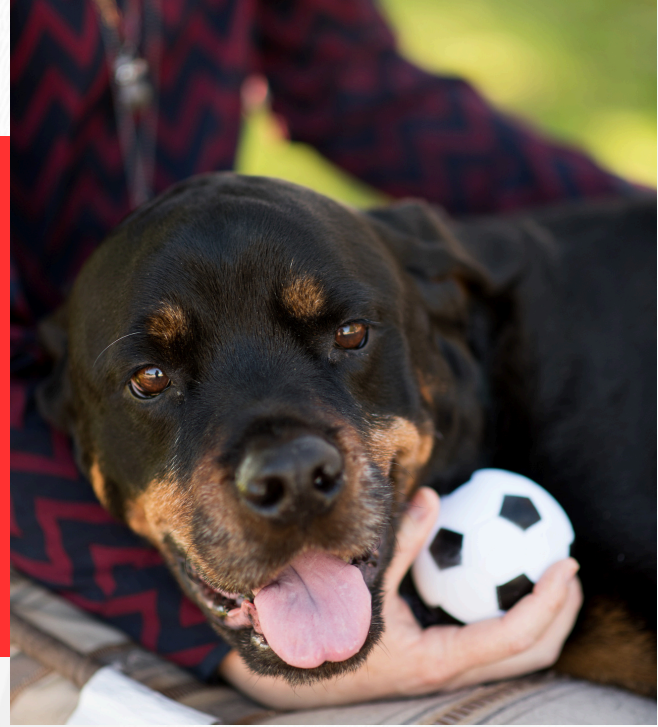


STUDY OPPORTUNITY
