## **Does your dog suffer from Atopic Dermatitis?**

Do you have a dog suffering from **Atopic Dermatitis**? **NC State Dermatology** is conducting a clinical trial to evaluate a **new injectable medication** similar to Xolair<sup>®</sup> (Omalizumab), which may provide relief for **weeks to months**.



### PARTICIPATION

- Patients will be required to come to NCSU for 8 study visits over the course of 16 weeks.
- Owners must closely monitor their dog at home and record in an Owner Diary.

### This study is FULLY FUNDED

- ✓ Physical exams
- ✓ Bloodwork & urinalysis
- $\checkmark$  Three doses of the injectable medication
- ✓ Free serum allergy testing

### **INCLUSION CRITERIA**

- ✓ Must have well-controlled NON-SEASONAL atopic dermatitis
- ✓ Food allergies must be ruled out
- $\checkmark$  Must be on **flea prevention** for the duration of the study

**X** Current Cytopoint treatment and previous immunotherapy are NOT allowed
