

ANNUAL CVM RESEARCH FORUM

The Annual CVM Research Forum and Litwack Lecture is scheduled for ***Wednesday, December 3, 2025.***

Trainees (undergraduates, DVM students, graduate students, house officers, post-doctoral fellows) & **Staff** are eligible to present an oral or poster presentation. Oral presentation spots are limited and those not selected will be assigned a poster presentation. Please note on your abstract submission if you are interested in an oral presentation spot.

- Oral presentation - limited to 10 minutes (eight minutes for presentation and two minutes for questions).
- Poster presentation - limited to 6 minutes (four minutes for presentation and two minutes for questions).

Prizes for oral and poster categories will be awarded.

The abstract deadline is 5:00 pm on Friday, November 7th.

Abstracts must be submitted via email to the Continuing Education Office at ceresgistration@ncsu.edu and should indicate the preference for oral or poster presentation. We will try to accommodate the preferences as much as possible.

General Instructions:

Abstracts that do not meet all format guidelines will be rejected without review.

Required Abstract Format

Font = Arial, 12 pt, single spaced, 1" margins, 1 page limit must include the following information:

- Title – In all CAPITAL letters (line #1)
- **Author Name (Bold)** with Category: undergraduate, veterinary student, house officer, graduate student, postdoc, staff (line #2)
- Co-Author(s), Faculty Mentor (underline) (line #3)
- Email address(es)
- Mobile # (Award winners contacted by Research Office before ceremony):
- Affiliation(s): Use NCSU CVM when appropriate
- Abstract: Limited to 250 words
- Funding Source(s): if applicable
- Is your research Clinical or Basic?
- Please provide primary subject category for presentation: Biomedical Engineering, Cell Biology, Clinical Medicine, Gastroenterology, Genetics, Immunology, Infectious Disease, Neurosciences, Pain, Pharmacology, Regenerative Medicine or Other

Additional instructions for power point format, presentation schedule and set up will be provided for both Oral and Poster Presentations after the abstract deadline.
